Parcel 2 Meeting 4: Preferred Design Progress - November 19, 2019






View from Boomerang





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MATERIALS & FURNISHINGS | THIS WAS ONCE A POND

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The Preferred Design material palette connects Parcel 2 to the rest of the Greenway through furnishings and finishes. The palette will highlight the boardwalk through the use of warm wood. Similar to other parcels on the Greenway, Parcel 2 will reuse "Big Dig" granite for walls and seating. All other furnishings will build upon Greenway standards for continuity and ease of maintenance.














