

Project Location


- New 240,000 GSF Recreation Center
- Project location on east side of Lower Campus (current site of Edmond's Residence Hall)
- New building will replace the outdated 1972 Flynn Recreation Complex
- Building location is consistent with the original Institutional Master Plan



Institutional Master Plan



 filled to make way
 for lower campus
 which has led to
 a very high water
 table.



Current Context

- Lower campus currently mix of Athletic fields, stadium, recreation, housing, theater.
- Topography approx. 30'-40' lower than middle campus, strong visual connections to middle campus, especially Gasson Hall tower.
- Strong visual presence of Pine Tree Preserve, Evergreen cemetery landscape at north along St. Thomas More Road and Reservoir.
- Lower campus heavily activated during home games.




Site Considerations

- Limited available footprint
- Height limitations
- High water table
- Site topography
- Functional/operati onal needs



Site Analysis

- Heavy pedestrian desired line/connection from the Brighton campus to middle campus through the Recreation Center site.
- Large volume of pedestrian circulation anticipated from 2150 Residence Hall
- Strong visual connections to middle campus and existing naturalized areas of lower campus.



Landscape Connections




Landscape Design

- Strengthen campus connections: Rec Center entry on west side is vehicle free, addresses pedestrian connections from 2150 Residence Hall to Campanella Way.
- New grades and plaza on the west eliminates stairs to provide opportunities for seamless circulation and accessibility.
- West lawn spaces service as flexible social spaces for passive use, informal active use and events.
- Woodland planting along building offers intimate walking/seating experience and provides human scale to the landscape.
- Improve streetscape along St. Thomas More Rd., Woodland planting to soften the building façade and new trees consistent spacing

- Views In / Out








Building Program

- Key Programmatic Components
 - Central gathering/lounge space
 - Multipurpose activity court
 - Natatorium w/ 2 pools
 - 4-court gymnasium and jogging track
 - 3 tennis courts
 - Weights + fitness space
 - Multipurpose rooms
 - Support space








